

How much is it to play ?

The first three 3 sessions are **free**.

To join us, simply turn up, we hire the booking for 50 weeks a year. We welcome anyone who shows an interest in badminton.

All ages, all abilities, all year, all welcome. For those who don't have rackets we let you use our own stock of club rackets for free.

Each member contributes to the cost of shuttles, and venue hall hire by an inexpensive session fee, payable every time you visit us.

There is also an annual fee payable to cover Badminton England (BE) insurance and club development funding.

These fees will be £40 for adults, £20 for juniors, £30 for concessions, **with discounts available for players already affiliated in other BE clubs, or on the Badminton England Coaching Register as well as families, and adult/concession couples. Other membership payment options are available.**

*The free water bottle & hand towel will be given when players have paid their annual membership fee from as an useful incentive to join if they play for a month.

The club has decided to adopt special concessions to attract and retain different under-represented groups of members such as:-

- Young People in full time education
- Retired/Senior Citizen/Older People
- Registered Disabled Persons
- People with an autistic spectrum disorder
- People on low incomes / benefits
- Those who work for the armed forces
- Those who work for the emergency services

Coaching Provision

The club has access to a number of coaches trained to UKCC Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3 standards.

All coaches undergo an enhanced CRB/DBS check, and receive specific training on equity in coaching, child protection, disabled awareness and first aid.

The club also encourages and trains new coaches to level 1 / 2 standard.

We will provide in due course, adult and junior coaching sessions at our venue as well offering hints and tips to our players.

Develop & Learn with Us

Members are encouraged to learn new skills and gain qualifications such as First Aider Courses, Specific Coaching Qualifications and related Courses and for our junior players, Badminton England's Young Officials Award, Junior Helper Award, Duke of Edinburgh, Girl Guide/Scouts Sports Badges, and Sports Leader courses.

Calne Badminton Club is registering as a small local charitable incorporated organisation (CIO) and as such requires volunteers to coach, develop, manage and run the club and the charity.

We welcome any one who shows an interest in voluntary work and as a Wiltshire Time Credit partner, every person who spends an hour volunteering in the club gains a time credit that can be used in a wide variety of local community organisations such as Gyms, Spirit Hill, Swimming, and lots of others as a free reward.
